

The offices of President and Vice President of the United States are not included in a Straight Party vote. This contest must be voted separately.




STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING

- a. Unless otherwise noted, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party in PARTISAN OFFICES. It is not necessary to select individual candidates for PARTISAN OFFICES if you vote a Straight Party.
- b. You may vote a Straight Party AND ALSO vote for a candidate of a different party in any individual office.
- c. In any multi-seat office, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party. If you individually vote for any candidate in a multi-seat office, you must also individually select all other candidates in that office for whom you wish to vote in order for all votes for that office to be counted.
- d. If you do not vote a Straight Party below, you may vote by marking each office separately.
- e. A Straight Party vote does not include US President and Vice President, unaffiliated candidates, nonpartisan offices, issues or referenda.
